Refined & elegantly balanced it boasts an aromatic complexity of ripe gooseberries & rhubarb, Ladoucette is one of the top producers of Pouilly-Fumé.
20. CHATEAU DE TRACY, POUILLY FUMÉ 2010 £34.00
Another of the very finest producers of the Loire. Amazingly intense.

21. KREUZNACHER KRONENBURG 2012 - Riesling Kabinett, Nahe £17.50
An elegant, fragrant and spicy wine in a distinctive blue bottle which is traditional in this area.
22. GAU BICKELHEIMER KURFURSTENSTUCK 2011 - Auslese, Rhienhessen £17.50
23. ALBIGER HUNDSKOPF RIESLING KABINETT 2012 - Koster Wolf £19.50
Medium dry, fresh and lively with a delicate peach aroma.
24. JOHANNISBERGER ERNTERBRINGER 2012 - Villa Gutenberg £21.00
A heady sensation of sweetness on the nose - peaches and honey - backed up by a perfect 'sweet and sour' balance on the palate with floral and citrus notes.

25. PAZOS DAS BRUXAS, ALBARINO 2013 - Torres £18.50
An intensely aromatic wine fruit notes (green apple and lemon peel) with clean undertones of hay. Fresh on the palate, sweet and soft upon entry and culminating in a long, elegant finish.
26. JEAN LEON 3055, CHARDONNAY 2011 - Penedes £19.50
Fragrant, concentrated aromas of blossoms and exotic fruits, with a hint of barrique. Very fruity, with elegant freshness on the palate.
27. FRANSOLA 2008 - Torres £23.00
Crisp full bodied Sauvignon.
28. MILMANDA 2007 - Torres £34.00
Pure Chardonnay Torres top wine, in the French style!

Italy

30. PINOT GRIGIO SUPERIORE 2010 - Cantina Briganze £17.00
31. FALANGHINA DEL SANNIO 2012 - Feudi di San Gregorio £21.00
The nose is intense and aromatic, packed with spring blossom and tropical fruits. The palate is quite full-bodied, dry, succulently textured and dripping with tropical flavours of melon, quince and passion fruit.

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Chile

32. CASSILERO DEL DIABLO, PINOT GRIGIO 2011 - Concha y Torro £16.50
This is classic Pinot Grigio with a distinctive Chilean twist. With floral aromas leading to fresh apple and ripe lemon flavours.
33. CORDILLERA, SAUVIGNON BLANC 2013 - Torres £19.50
34. 20 BARRELS, CHARDONNAY 2007 - Cono Sur £24.00
Chile Award Trophy, "Best Chardonnay".
35. AMELIA, CHARDONNAY 2009 - Concha Y Torro £34.00
Fine, honey and honeysuckle nose, with very ripe fruit and an unctuous, almost buttery quality to the fruit. The palate has lots of ripe melon and pear.

36. MOORE'S CREEK, CHARDONNAY 2011 - Tyrells £18.00
Peaches and stone fruits abound on the nose and palate while the subtle use of oak combines well for a refreshing but full mouth feel.
37. SADDLE CREEK, CHARDONNAY/SEMILLON 2013 £17.50
A delicate blend of herbaceous Semillon and exotic tropical Chardonnay fruit character.
39. MOON MOUNTAIN, CHARDONNAY 2011 - Tyrells £28.00
Punchy aroma of soft peach, melon & cinnamon, a hint of lemon. Long & juicy, restrained but bright.

A concentrated palate of ripe stone-fruit, toasty vanillin oak and fresh acidity.
42. VERGELEGEN PREMIUM SAUVIGNON 2013 - Stellenbosch £18.50
43. VERGELEGEN RESERVE SEMILLON 2011 - Stellenbosch £22.00
Attractive gold green colour. Nose shows intense citrus, orange – marmalade, honey and spice.
44. VERGELEGEN GVB PRESTIGE 2010 £35.00
The Flagship wine! A powerful and complex nose of greengage, fresh herbs, lime and hot buttered toast, the palate is rich and layered with real polish and terrific balance.

A fantastic alternative to Pinot Gris or Sauvignon Blanc. Simply delicious!
47. SAINT CLAIR, RIESLING 2012 - Marlborough £22.00
Luscious, Medium dry, with an intense floral bouquet.
48. SAINT CLAIR, SAUVIGNON BLANC 2012 - Marlborough £22.00
International winemaker of the year.
49. SAINT CLAIR, CHARDONNAY 2011 - Marlborough £22.00
Crisp gooseberry & passion fruit with, a crisp zingy finish. Silver medal winner.
50. SAINT CLAIR, OMAKA RESERVE CHARDONNAY 2010 - Marlborough £30.00
Not the usual over oaked New World Chardonnay. Pure class - look out Meursault!

This is a wine Cloudy Bay would aspire to! Probably the finest Sauvignon in New Zealand therefore, probably, one of the finest in the World.

No mistaking the New World style of this wine. Intense aromas of grapefruit, citrus, kiwi and fresh cut grass greet the nose.
54. LA CREMA, CHARDONNAY 2012 - Sonoma Coast £30.00
Bursts with enticing aromas of citrus, floral notes, butterscotch, lemon peel and a slight spicy quality. In the mouth, flavors of citrus, pear and honeysuckle combine with subtle toast and caramel, adding richness and texture to the long, lingering finish.
55. MARIMAR TORRES CHARDONNAY 2008 - Russian River Valley £38.00
Copious amounts of fleshy, buttery, apple & honeyed fruit.

60. SANTA DIGNA, ROSÉ 2010 - Torres Chile £15.50
61. SUNSET POINT, ZINFANDELL BLUSH 2012 - Puglia Italy £17.50
62. FETZER, WHITE ZINFANDEL BLUSH 2012 - California £18.50

Spicy, fruity aroma with hints of pine, cherry and herbs, a little bit of minerals. Fresh and fruity with typical, hints of dark cherries, roses and pines.
98. NEBBIOLO D'ALBA 2012 - Renato Ratti £24.00
Fine, delicate and persistent bouquet with characteristic trace scents of strawberry and raspberry. Pleasantly bitterish, velvety, at once elegant and full.
99. BARON RICOSOLI, CHIANTI CLASSICO 2009 - Brolio £25.00
A gorgeous wine with sweet dark cherries, licorice and tobacco bursting from the glass in this big, hugely rewarding Chianti Classico.
100. BAROLO MARCENESCO 2010 - Renato Ratti £45.00
Savoury with a lovely nose of fleshy ripe black fruit and some mocha in this lovely interpretation of the nebbiolo grape. Full-bodied and layered for complexity with a long finish. Barolo in all its glory, with those exotic and elusive wild violet and crushed wild raspberry notes on the palate.

Intense, bursting with fruit.

Aromas of spicy fruit and cedar, harmonious fruit and spice on the palate with a pleasing dry finish.
106. MANSO DE VALASCO, CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2008 - Torres £26.00
Torres flagship wine. Full, pungent, deep-flavoured with a hint of sweet oak.
108. MATETIC EQ, SYRAH 2006 £32.00
Incredible gold medal winning wine, intense dark colour with violet & black.

116. TRIVENTO PRIVATE SELECTION, MALBEC 2011 £18.50
Chunky, seriously fruity Mable from the Mendoza region of Argentina.
117. DON DAVID, MALBEC 2010 - Michel Torino £20.00
Rich, cassis-scented black fruit flavours with warm & spicy finish.
118. GOLDEN RESERVE, MALBEC 2011 £26.00
This wonderful wine is brick red in colour with some purple notes. On the nose it has aromas of ripe red fruit, vanilla, smoke, toast bread and earthy spice. On the palate, it is concentrated and expressive.
119. ISCAY, MERLOT/MALBEC 2007 - Trapiche £36.00
Trapiche's "Icon Wine" outstanding pepper nose and complex palate.

California

110. BONTERRA, ZINFANDEL 2010 £19.50
Powerful rich flavours of sweet plum, blackcurrant and black pepper are rounded by soft, sweet tannins and hints of vanilla.
112. BONTERRA, THE McNAB 2006 £29.00
Aromas of black cherries, dark chocolate and a hint of liquorice., spicy cherries and a touch of mint on the finish. Soft tannins, the wine is very drinking well now. A Bordeaux blend; predominantly Merlot, with some Petite Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon.
113. MARIMAR TORRES, PINOT NOIR 2001 - Russian River Valley £34.00
Unlike the lighter colour and sometimes delicate Pinots of Burgundy, this is a rich, deep Pinot, full of slightly chewy dark berry and cherry fruits with hints of cola, Asian spices and forest floor adding to the complexity.

Dark plum with a ripe nose of blackcurrant, blackberry, cedarwood, coffee and spice.

A top South African producer's version of a Bordeaux blend. Dominant Cabernet Franc grapes add crunchiness to the darker Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich, warming and smoothly satisfying.
